◆ Yn adran yr **wŷn**, y safon gorffenedig a'r pwysau yn amrywiol iawn gyda'r wŷn pwysau ysgafn a safonol yn gwerthu orau. Pris uchaf y cilo yn mynd i **H Griffith, Castell**- 400c y cilo.

◆ Prisiau cryf yn parhau yn adran y **mogau a'r meheryn lladd** eto wythnos yma gyda ambell i gorlan yn clirio dros £200. Pris uchaf yn mynd i **Jones, Parciau Home Farm** am gorlan o fogau Texel - £228.

◆ Safon dda o **wartheg** ymlaen gyda phwysau uchel i weld ar rhan fwyaf ohonynt. Cystadleuaeth dda i weld ar bob anifal ddaeth drwy'r cylch gwerthu a hynny yn cael ei adlewyrchu yn y prisiau. Yr uchafbris oeds £3,286 - **D Thomas, Ty'n Simdde**

◆ Ar y cyfan, diwrnod da iawn arall o werthu ym Mart Bryncir, yr haul yn gwenu dros y Mart a theimlad clir fod y gwanwyn wedi cyrraedd. Roedd hyder ymhlith prynwyr, cystadleuaeth fywiog a iach i'w gweld ym mhob adran, gan sicrhau diwrnod llwyddiannus arall o werthu.

◆ Fewer sheep forward today as the period of Ramadan draws to a close ahead of the festival of Eid al-Fitr, however they sold to very encouraging prices. Cattle numbers were also slightly less, excellent prices continuing to be seen – demand for cattle remains strong, so please get in touch if you have stock to sell.

◆ In the **Hoggets** section, finish cover and weight varied considerably, with the light and standard weight lambs selling best. The highest price per kilo went to **H Griffith, Castell** – 400p/kg.

◆ Strong prices continued in the **Cull Ewes and Cull Rams** section again this week, with plenty of pens clearing £200 and above. The top price went to **Jones, Parciau Home Farm** for a pen of Texel ewes at £228.

◆ Quality entry of **cattle** was present, with plenty of weight to be seen on the majority of them. Good competition was evident for every one that came through the sale ring, and this was clearly reflected in the prices achieved. The top price of the day was £3,286, awarded to **D Thomas, Ty'n Simdde**.

◆ Overall, another very good day's trading was enjoyed at Mart Bryncir, the sun shining over the Mart and a clear sense that spring has arrived. Confidence amongst buyers, along with lively and healthy competition evident throughout every section, ensuring another successful day of trading.
