

BRYNCIR STORE SALE 6/9/2021

The Monday sale had an entry of just over 200 store cattle. The stock forward were of the highest quality and met an outstanding trade. A large proportion of the entry saw steers & heifers selling for over £1300. Buyers were present for all types. Strong steers topped at £1570 for a Limx from DH,MI & DH Jones Maes Mawr, with Messrs Williams Gesail selling Limx to £1560. Strong Charx sold to £1490 for R & C & RW Jones Crugan. Heifers peaked at £1430 for an 18m Charx from E Hughes & son Eithinog Wen who sold others to £1415. Limx sold to £1410 for TG Jones Cae Graig, The overall steer AV was £1130 with heifers AV £1022. Enter cattle with confidence for the next sale Monday 13th September.

Breeding cattle- A small entry on offer saw plenty of demand with aged cows from Messrs Pierce Morfa Glas selling for £1380.

Store Sheep- Over 1200 store lambs & Breeding ewes forward. Store lambs met an excellent trade up to £86 for xbred from B Hughes Ffridd. The overall AV for the mixed entry was £52. Large entries of ewes on offer which met a twin tier trade. Good quality ewes met with plenty of demand with 2nd quality being a more selective trade. Highest price pen of ewes was £174 for texelx from G Edwards Bwlch Y Ffordd. Suffx ewes sold to £158 from I Roberts Cellar.

Rams were a competitive trade with the top price being 500gns for a 2year old Beltex from A Franz Trefaes
